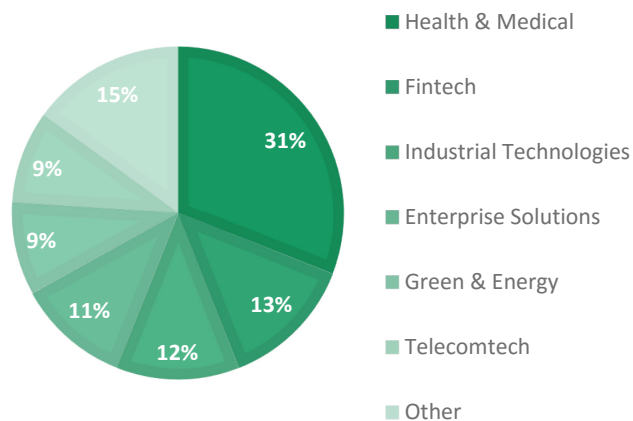
- 2500+ start-ups in Dublin

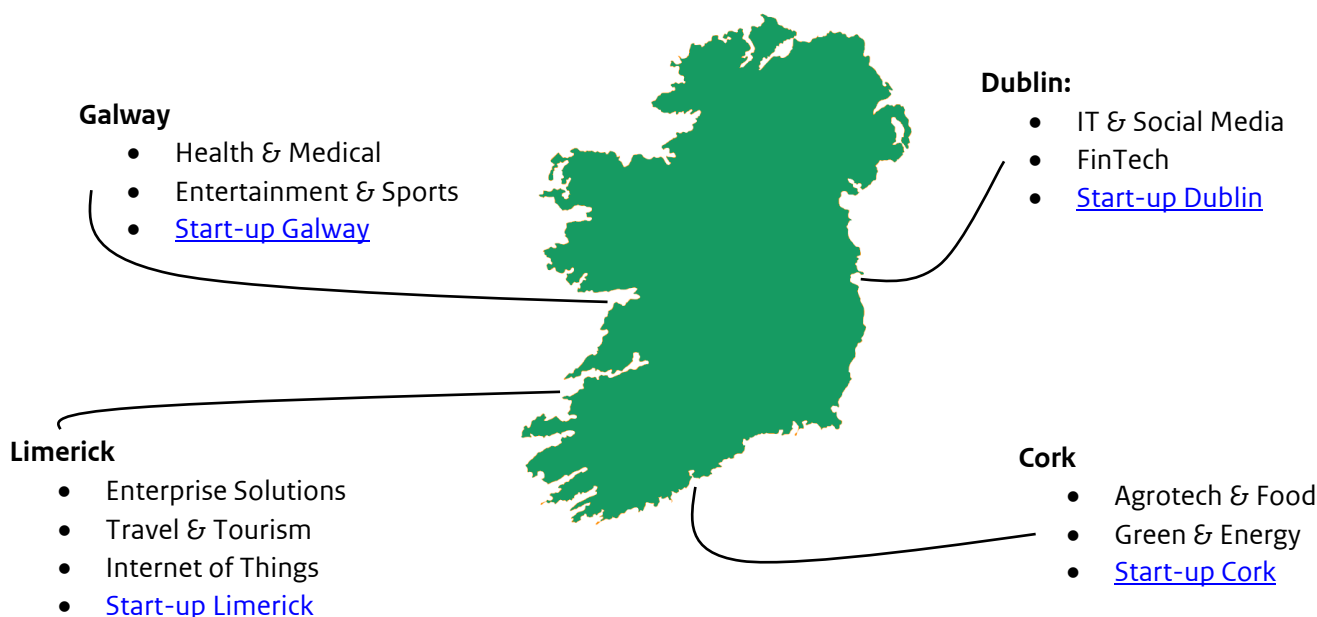
