Background introduction

The college is governed by the Jiangsu Provincial Department of Agriculture and Rural Affairs and aims to train applied and technical talents. Among more than 1,400 higher vocational colleges in the country, it is ranked the top 50, and it is the only agricultural college in the A category. The school has 72 colleges with more than 13,000 students, including more than 500 international students.

Current situation

In recent years, the college has established long-term cooperative relations with more than 10 universities and educational institutions in more than 10 countries and regions such as the United States, France, the Netherlands, Australia, and Taiwan, and sent teachers and students to universities and education in the Netherlands, Australia, France, and Taiwan. It has undertaken such cooperative projects as the Sino-Kenya Modern Agricultural Science and Technology Demonstration Park, the Sino-French Agricultural Training Center, the Agricultural Foreign Cooperation Technology Support and Talent Training Base.

The school has contacts with the Netherlands. In 2016 and 2017, it cooperated with Lentiz to send teachers and students to the Netherlands for training.

1. Technical cooperation: Demonstration and promotion of application of agricultural big data, cultivation technology, etc. (the local government plans to invest more than 700 million RMB in this field).
2. Technical training: Send teachers and students to the Netherlands to learn the most developed cultivation techniques or invite Dutch experts to come to the college to organize short-term trainings (the government special funds are available).
3. Demonstration center: Carry out various forms of international cooperation, such as jointly establish demonstration center of agricultural products processing center.
