Thailand – The Netherlands: Water sector activities update in H1/2021

1. MoU Water and the 1st Thailand – Netherlands Water Dialogue

On **15 March 2021** - the MOU signing Ceremony took place at the Netherlands Residence in Thailand. The Office of National Water Resources (ONWR) and the Embassy of the Netherlands in Thailand co-organized the first Thailand-Netherlands Water Dialogue.

The key takeaway of this gathering was to work together and share experiences between Thailand and The Netherlands, including the digitalization in water management. WEIS, The Water and Environmental Institute of the Federation of Thai Industries expressed interest to explore a possibility to work with the Netherlands Water Partnership (NWP) in the field of the industrial water management. Together the two kingdoms can work on solutions for water problems due to climate change.

2. Climate Adaptation Conference: session on Nature Based Solutions for coastal erosion challenges

On **17 March 2021**, the Embassy of the Netherlands in Thailand and the Ministry of National Resources and Environment (MoNRE) of Thailand jointly organized the Climate Adaptation Conference, as part of the Climate Adaptation Summit (CAS2021) hosted by the Dutch government. The Conference is aimed to share experiences and learn from each other on climate change impact and potential adaptive measures, focusing on Water and Agricultural & Food Security. The Thai Ministry of Natural Resources and Environment (MoNRE) of Thailand and the Embassy signed a **G2G cooperation on Environmental Management and Climate Action** on the cooperation in the field of environmental management, climate change and circular economy.

5. Bangkok Climate Adaptation virtual workshop at Bangkok Design Week (BKKDW2021)

On **8-9** July, the Netherlands Embassy in collaboration with the Netherlands Alumni Association of Thailand (NAAT), IHE Delft, University of Groningen, and CityCracker/Shma jointly organized a virtual workshop on "Bangkok Climate Adaptation" as part of the Bangkok Design Week. The workshop aimed to co-create urban strategy and design interventions for water and climate resilience in the urban context of Thailand, and to introduce the Dutch Adaptive Pathways approach. Dutch and Thai experts shared integrated solutions concerning resiliency, mobility, and green infrastructure development.

7. Rivers and Ocean Cleanup

On **3 February**, the Netherlands Embassy facilitated the MoU signing between the Department of Marine Coastal Resources (DMCR) of Thailand and The Ocean Cleanup Interception B.V. on river plastic research and interception. The Interceptor is The Ocean Cleanup's answer for river plastic waste. The main reason why Thailand is selected as one of many countries to deploy the interceptor is that Thailand has a right location with potential operators, staff and academia who can together further develop new innovations.
