PORTS & ENERGY TRANSITION

Houston has a port of major importance to the U.S. and is striving to become the global Energy 2.0 capital. In the Netherlands too, port infrastructure will play a crucial role in moving the energy transition forward. The focus is on establishing a hydrogen corridor between ports in Texas and the Netherlands, and in parallel create opportunities for clean-tech startups.



WATER MANAGEMENT & RESILIENCY

With continued sea level rise and weather events getting more severe, urban and coastal resilience is an increasingly important need in Texas. Dutch engineering and design expertise and its models of cooperation between business, academia and government can contribute to innovative strategies and solutions, including nature-based and hybrid designs.

Sports in the U.S. is huge, with over 30% of the global sports market. The industry continues to grow with upcoming events like Formula 1 and 2026 FIFA World Cup. Texas has major sports cities (Dallas ranked #1 US sports business city), 11 major league teams, innovative companies, and top-notch sports organizations. Plentiful opportunities for the Netherlands to add value to the market through innovation and tech, focusing on athlete performance, fan engagement, smart and sustainable venues, and addressing social issues such as mental health and diversity, equity and inclusion.
